

## **Chief Andrew Smalling**

Chief Smalling is a 17-year veteran of the Broward Sheriff's Office. He joined the agency in December 1991 as a road patrol deputy, following his career as a military intelligence officer in the United States Marine Corps. He has a wide range of experience at BSO working as a school resource officer, a detective sergeant in the Internal Affairs Division and as an Organized Crime Unit sergeant in the Strategic Investigations Division. He has also served as a Field Force commander and K-9 Unit commander. He is currently the Chief in the city of Lauderdale Lakes which contracts police services from BSO.

Chief Smalling received his Bachelor's degree from the Florida Institute of Technology and earned a Master's degree in Criminal Justice Administration from Lynn University. He is a graduate of the Broward Sheriff's Office Center for Advanced Criminal Justice Studies Executive Leadership Program and is currently an adjunct professor at Florida Memorial University.

Chief Smalling is President of the South Florida National Organization of Black Law Enforcement Executives (NOBLE), a member of the 100 Black Men of Greater Fort Lauderdale, a member of the International Association of Chiefs of Police (IACP), and an advisory board member of The Faith Center. His son Matthew is a sophomore at the University of Florida, and his daughter Stephanie is a High School junior.
